



UTILITY EMERGENCY SERVICES FUND (UESF) ELIGIBILITY

UESF grants are available to income-eligible customers to help pay off the balance of their bill if their service has been terminated or if they have received a shut off notice.

- Maximum grant amount is \$1,500
- Customers can apply for grants at designated intake sites (see “Intake Sites” below)

UESF Grant Eligibility Requirements:

- You may receive a UESF grant only once every two years
- You must have applied for LIHEAP and CRISIS first, if eligible
- You must have a zero balance after receiving the grant
- Household income is at or below 175 percent of Federal Poverty Level
