## WHAT IS LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS?

LNG is simply natural gas that has been converted to a liquid through a purification and cooling process. During its conversion to LNG, natural gas is cooled to around minus 260 degrees Fahrenheit.

Since PGW's LNG storage tanks first came on line, almost 50 years ago, the natural gas stored there has saved our customers more than \$4 billion.

# A CELEBRATION OF A PLANE SHARE Earth Day is a global event that brings people together

Earth Day is a global event that brings people together every year. This year it happens on April 22. PGW is proud to host its own Earth Day celebrations, to continue improving the environment we share by reducing our energy use, increasing our efficiency and promoting smart energy practices.

PGW is committed to improving the environment every day. Companywide, green initiatives continue to lower our energy use, improving the quality of life in Philadelphia and beyond.

- 250,000 kilowatt hours saved annually since converting to LED lighting
- 1,754 trees planted in Philadelphia region through our partnerships with the Philadelphia Eagles, Philadelphia Phillies, and Pennsylvania Horticultural Society
- 59.26 tons of electronic waste diverted from landfills since 2014

Beyond our own impact, PGW continues to invest in helping our neighbors with programs that improve efficiency and lower their bills.

PGW conservation programs have spent \$51.7 million since 2011 to help nearly 19,000 low-income customers lower their energy usage. We also have awarded \$8.9 million in rebates and grants to our customers for energy conservation.

Estimated savings over the lifetime of the conservation measures are 12.9 billion cubic feet of natural gas, 114,000 megawatt hours of electricity, and 27.8 million gallons of water.

These measures will reduce greenhouse gas emissions over their lifetime, equivalent to **759,060** metric tons of CO2. That is equivalent to removing 161,159 vehicles off the road for a year.

CALL 8-1-1 BEFORE YOU DIG.



Spring's arrival brings a renewed interest in planting flowers, redoing the yard or starting a garden. But before you put a shovel in the ground, there's one thing you need to do:

#### Call 8-1-1.

An underground utility line is damaged every six minutes nationwide as a result of not calling 811 before digging, according to data collected by Common Ground Alliance.

To reduce the risk of hitting an underground utility service line, PGW reminds home and business owners:

- Always call 811 at least 3 business days before you plan to dig. Calls can be made 24 hours a day.
- Confirm with your One Call Center that all utility lines have been marked.
- Don't begin any work if lines aren't marked.
- Once a site is accurately marked, you can begin to dig around the marked areas.

Calling 811 before you begin your project isn't just a good idea, it's the law.
