time, they were lit by employees of the newly formed Philadelphia Gas Works. It also uses improved temperature and air flow management to deliver significant savings, greater levels of energy efficiency and increased operational reliability.

In 1926 Philadelphia became one of the first cities in the U.S. to replace coal-fired water heaters with cleaner, cheaper natural gas powered versions. And PGW was the first in the industry to develop the single-point ignition range oven, in 1945.

At PGW, innovation and community spirit often

go hand-in-hand. That was certainly the case in 1932, when the Girl Scouts of America baked their very first cookies in PGW natural gas ovens, and sold them in the windows of a PGW store.


In 1983 PGW was instrumental in creating the Utility Emergency
Services Fund, which helps low income customers pay their utility bills, for which it received the American Gas Association's Merit Award.
