This **FREE** service works with utilities to keep your family safe.

How it works:

- 🔦 Call at least **3 business days** before starting a project.
- 🔦 Utilities **mark underground service lines** with washable paint or flags.
- 🔦 **Dig carefully** using the designated areas as a guide.

These simple steps improve safety and help prevent costly damage to your property and utility lines.

PROTECT AGAINST CO POISONING

Carbon Monoxide (CO) is a colorless, odorless gas that can cause illness or even death.

Tips to keep your family safe:

- Install a CO detector on each floor of your home.
 - Contact Philly311 (philly311.com) to get a smoke alarm, which can be installed by the Fire Department.
- Schedule an annual inspection of your home's natural gas furnace and appliances.
 - Enroll in Parts & Labor with Check and Adjust (pgwplp.com) to have a certified technician inspect your equipment and perform repairs.
- Never use an oven to heat your home.
- Check/replace your detector's batteries when changing your clocks in the spring and fall.
- Have your chimney checked annually to make sure it's free of debris.
- Make sure gas appliances are vented properly.

PLANNING TO MOVE?

Visit PGWorks.com to start, stop, or transfer PGW natural gas service.

Remember to contact PGW at least seven days in advance of your service start or end date.

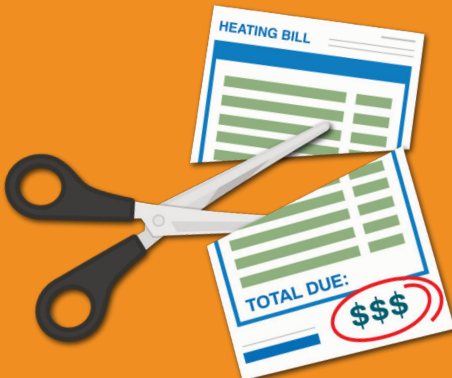
PGW will conduct a final meter reading and transfer or close your account once your move date is confirmed.
