

#### **PGW JOINS METHANE CHALLENGE TO BUILD GREENER DHILLY**



We have accepted a new challenge in our efforts to lower emissions and improve the environment.

PGW has joined the Environmental **Protection Agency's Methane** Challenge. We pledge to replace at least two percent of our cast iron and vintage steel mains with newer, modern pipes, along with new service lines, every year through 2022.

"PGW intends to meet or surpass the goals set by the Methane Challenge and strengthen our commitment to environmental responsibility," said Janelle Johnson-Grummert, PGW director of sustainability.

PGW's main and service replacement program has reduced 78.000 metric tons of CO2 since 2005. Last year, PGW invested \$87 million to modernize and replace 34 miles of its infrastructure.

Along with environmental benefits, pipe upgrades ensure the longterm safety and reliability of the natural gas distribution system in Philadelphia.
