## HERE TO HELP

As temperatures drop, the cost of monthly heating can go up. Let PGW help your family stay warm.

#### LOW INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

(LIHEAP) gives low-income households up to \$1,000 for home heat. LIHEAP is open to renters and homeowners and DOES NOT have to be repaid.

**CRISIS ASSISTANCE** helps income-eligible customers without utility service or who have received a shut-off notice. Customers can apply for both Crisis Assistance and LIHEAP money at the same time.

**PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS** aid customers behind on their PGW bill with a repayment plan.

**CUSTOMER RESPONSIBILITY PROGRAM (CRP)** can cut your gas bill in half. CRP lets customers pay less each month and past debt is forgiven.

UTILITY EMERGENCY SERVICES FUND (UESF) is designed to bring a customer's unpaid utility bill to \$0. Maximum award is \$1,500.

- · Set your thermostat as low as is comfortable for your family while you're awake.
- · Apply weatherstripping or caulk to windows and doors to prevent warm air from escaping.
- Take advantage of natural light to heat your home during the day. Close draperies and shades at night to keep warm air inside.
- · Lower the temperature on your water heater to the warm setting (120 degrees).
