# \$ave On Your Bill

Simple steps to stay warm & lower your energy bills.

- Use weatherstripping or caulk to close cracks/ spaces around doors and windows to keep warm air from escaping.
- Set your thermostat as low as possible. When away or asleep, lower it a few degrees for extra savings.
- Reverse a ceiling fan to spin clockwise forcing warm air down from the ceiling. Turn it off if no one is in the room.
- Keep the temperature of the water heater on the warm setting (120°F).

If you think you smell gas, leave the area immediately, then call PGW at 215-235-1212.

- NEVER flip the light switch on or off.

- **NEVER** try to locate the source of the gas leak.
- NEVER try to shut off any natural gas valves or appliances.
- NEVER re-enter the building or return to the area until a qualified utility representative says it is safe to do so.
