SLOW DOWN, **STAY ALERT IN WORK ZONES**

PGW will be doing more work around the City as the weather warms up. Safety is our top priority, do your part to keep everyone safe while our crews are working.

Nearly 900 people were killed nationwide in work zone crashes in 2022, the Federal Highway Administration reports.





Natural gas has an unpleasant, rotten egg-like odor for easy detection and your safety.

If you think you smell gas, leave the area immediately, then call PGW at 215-235-1212.

Remember, if you think you smell gas:

- NEVER flip the light switch on or off.
- NEVER use electrical devices.
- NEVER try to locate the source of the gas leak.
- NEVER try to shut off any natural gas valves or appliances.
- **NEVER** re-enter the building or return to the area until a qualified utility representative says it is safe to do so.
