## **PA Public Utility Service Termination Moratorium Ending**

Effective November 9, 2020, the absolute utility service termination moratorium will lift and service terminations for non-payment can resume for customers with past due bills.

Please contact PGW if you are facing financial challenges. Don't wait: contact PGW to make a payment or call PGW immediately at 215-235-1777, Monday-Friday, between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. A PGW representative can explain your options, and any assistance that may be available to assist you and avoid service termination.

If you are a residential or small business customer not enrolled in a payment arrangement or payment assistance program, or you have not notified PGW that your household income is at or below 300 percent of the Federal Poverty Level: your service may be subject to termination. Call today.

PGW recognizes the hardships many families may be facing as a result of the COVID-19 health crisis. We're here to help by offering programs, grants and energy tips to help lower your monthly bill and assist you if you've fallen behind on payments.

- Enroll in a payment arrangement program like Budget Billing or a payment assistance program like CRP or LIHEAP.

Right now, PGW is conducting residential gas safety inspections.

These inspections are required by law every three years to assess the condition of the gas meter as well as service line piping, and are quickly completed.

If you receive a gas safety home inspection request by phone from PGW, please contact us at

215-235-1000, M-F between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. to schedule your appointment.

Our representatives will explain the process and answer any questions you may have.

Safety checks will be scheduled in advance with customers and PGW technicians will:

- · Have a PGW badge;
- Arrive in official PGW vehicle; and
- Wear PGW-branded clothing.
