Apply early! LIHEAP

Get a head start on your cold weather gas bills.

A free LIHEAP grant means more money to pay for heating. If you received LIHEAP last year, your personal application is on its way.

To make sure you don't miss out on grants up to \$1,000:

- Check 'natural gas' in **Section 4**
- Write 'Philadelphia Gas Works' and your PGW account number in **Section 6**
- Send 30-days proof of income with your application

HAVE YOUR APPLIANCES CHECKED REGULARLY



For your safety it is important to have major appliances and equipment – such as furnaces, boilers, ranges, water heaters, and clothes dryers – periodically inspected.

If you're buying a Parts and Labor Plan, don't forget to add the Check and Adjust service.

Failure to have this equipment properly maintained could lead to property damage, personal injury, or even death.

Have a trained professional perform a safety inspection on all fuel-burning appliances each year.

The trained professional should check to make sure:

- All appliances are installed and operating properly.
- All burners receive enough outside/fresh air for complete combustion.
- All vents, chimneys and flues are clear and well connected.

Other Safety Tips:

- Never use an oven or range as a space heater.
- Never let the car run in an attached or enclosed garage.
- Never sleep in a room with an unvented gas or kerosene space heater.

THINK YOU SMELL GAS?

Natural gas has an unpleasant, rotten egg-like odor for easy detection and your safety.

If you think you smell gas, leave the area immediately, then call PGW at 215-235-1212. Remember, if you think you smell gas:

- **NEVER** flip the light switch on or off.
- **NEVER** use electrical devices.
- **NEVER** use an open flame, matches or lighter.
- **NEVER** try to locate the source of the gas leak.
- **NEVER** try to shut off any natural gas valves or appliances.
- **NEVER** re-enter the building or return to the area until a qualified utility representative says it is safe to do so.
