PROTECT YOURSELF AGAINST



Recent news stories showcase the need to be vigilant when unexpected people arrive at your home. Criminals may pose as utility workers to gain entry into homes and businesses. We continue to work with law enforcement to combat this issue for the safety of you, and your loved ones.

To arm yourself against people falsely claiming to be PGW workers, follow these important tips:

Ask for PGW branded ID – All PGW employees carry photo ID. If someone at your door does not have it, or refuses to produce ID, don't let them into your home. Call 911 immediately.

Don't give out personal information – PGW employees who come to your home will never ask for your credit card, social security or account numbers or request any other personally identifiable information. **Any doubts?** – Don't hesitate to call PGW directly. This extra step offers you a greater level of safety and security. After all, your safety is our first priority.

Call 911 – If you have any uncertainty, call 911. The Philadelphia Police Department has a direct line

to PGW and can verify a utility worker's identity.
