THIRD-PARTY NOTIFICATION OFFERS ADDED PROTECTION

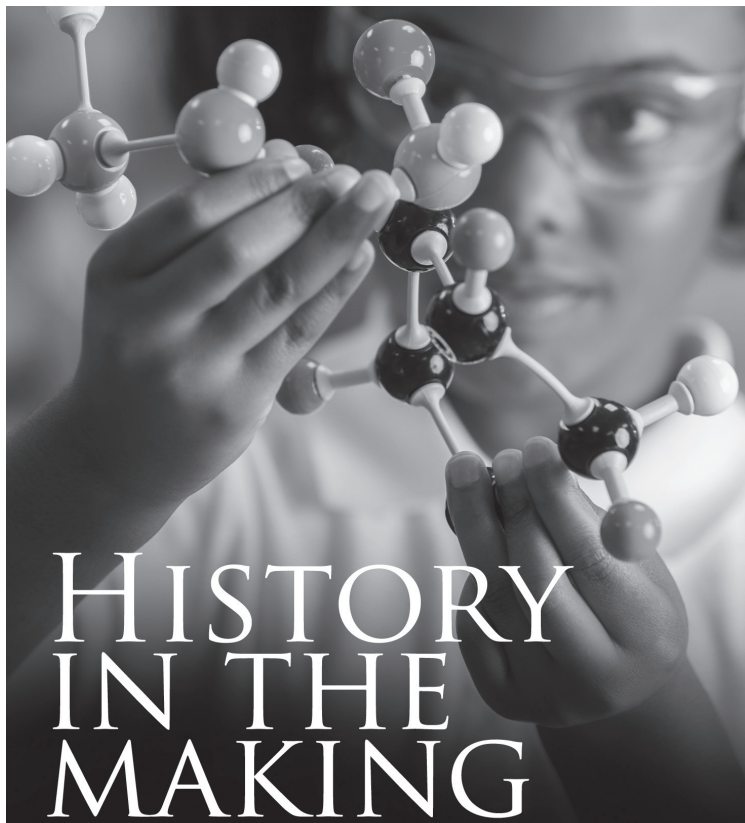
PGW Third-Party Notification allows a PGW customer to select a third party to be notified if they are in danger of losing service due to non-payment.

Protect Yourself From Carbon Monoxide Poisoning

Carbon monoxide (CO) is a colorless, odorless and potentially dangerous gas that can be produced by home appliances and other fuel-burning equipment that are not working properly.

Cases of CO poisoning increase in the winter months. It can cause sickness - or even death. To protect your family:

- Have all your fuel-burning appliances serviced regularly by a qualified technician.
- Have a CO detector/alarm installed if you don't already, and test it twice a year.
- Never use an oven to heat your home.

Remember, you can't smell, taste or see CO poisoning. If you suspect poisoning, call 911.
