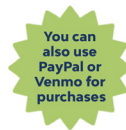

TECHNICIANS PERFORM METER SAFETY CHECK

To maintain our commitment to safety, PGW must inspect the natural gas meter and service lines at your property every three years.

If you receive an in-home meter and safety inspection request from PGW, **please call 215-235-1000, M-F between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. to schedule your appointment.** Our representatives will explain the process and answer any questions you may have.

PGW technicians:

- Have a PGW badge;
- Arrive in an official PGW vehicle; and
- Wear PGW-branded clothing.

PREVENT CO POISONING

Carbon Monoxide (CO) is a colorless, odorless, poisonous gas that can be produced by fuel-burning appliances.

To protect your family:

- Have fuel-burning appliances serviced by a qualified technician.
- Install a CO detector and have it checked twice a year.
- Never use an oven to heat your home.
- Call 9-1-1 if you suspect CO poisoning.
