PREPARE NOW TO SAVE MONEY ON WINTER HEATING BILLS

HERE ARE SOME SIMPLE, ENERGY SAVING TIPS:

- Clean or replace your heating system's air filter.
- Make sure air vents are not blocked.
- Keep doors and air vents closed in rooms that are not being used.
- Use caulking and weather stripping around doors and windows to reduce air flow.
- Have your gas furnace cleaned and serviced by a professional for greater efficiency.

- Replace old appliances with energy-efficient models carrying the ENERGY STAR label.
- Add a layer of insulation around ventilator ducts and water pipes that pass through unheated areas of your home.
- Cover bare floors with carpeting or rugs.
 The layers add comfort and retain heat.
- Direct your vents' airflow across the floor because warm air rises.

THINK YOU SMELL GAS?

Natural gas has an unpleasant, rotten egg-like odor for easy detection and your safety.

If you think you smell gas, leave the area immediately, then call PGW at 215-235-1212. Remember, if you think you smell gas:

NEVER use electrical devices.

NEVER use an open flame, matches or lighter.

NEVER try to locate the source of the gas leak.

NEVER try to shut off any natural gas valves or appliances.

NEVER flip the light switch on or off.

NEVER re-enter the building or return to the area until a qualified utility representative says it is safe to do so.
