

Before you move, remember to **contact PGW at least seven days in advance** to turn off or transfer your gas service. A service turn on, off or transfer can be requested at www.pgworks.com or by calling us at (215) 235-1000. Our Customer Care Team is available to assist you Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

PGW will conduct a final meter reading and transfer your account once your move date is confirmed.

As warmer temperatures arrive - keep it lit

Avoid the need for expensive repairs by keeping your heater pilot on year-round. Keeping the pilot lit – even on hot summer days – will keep your heater parts dry, rust-free and ready for when cold weather returns.

The cost of keeping your pilot lit is minimal and will save you the hassle of having to re-light it each winter.
