Safety check-in

Summer fun begins with safety.

As more visitors travel into Philadelphia, college students and recent grads relocate here, and businesses set up shop around town, PGW wants everyone to continue to enjoy the benefits of safe, reliable natural gas service. You can help us do that by remembering a few things:

- Use your nose. Natural gas has a rotten egg-like odor on purpose. If you think you smell natural gas, leave the area then call PGW at (215) 235-1212 at anv time.
- Call 8-1-1 Before You Dig. The service is free and helps ensure everyone's safety. Remember, it's the law.
- · Report suspected gas theft. The theft of natural gas is dangerous and should be reported immediately by calling (215) 684-6383. Your call is confidential and important.
- Know the facts about Carbon Monoxide (CO). Prevent CO poisoning by installing a CO detector and checking and replacing its batteries regularly.

If you think you smell natural gas: \checkmark Don't use electrical devices,

an open flame, matches, or lighters;

✓ Never try to locate the source

✓ Don't shut off or turn on natural gas valves or appliances;

✓ Never re-enter the area unless a qualified PGW representative allows you to return,
