FALL NATURAL GAS SAFETY: have your fuel burning appliances checked annually



For your safety it is important to have major natural gas, electric or other fuel-burning appliances and equipment – such as furnaces, boilers, ranges, water heaters and clothes dryers – periodically inspected. Failure to have this equipment properly maintained could lead to property damage, personal injury or even death.

Have a trained professional heating contractor perform a safety inspection on all fuel-burning appliances each year.

The contractor should check to make sure:

- All appliances are installed and operating properly.
- All burners receive enough outside/fresh air for complete combustion.
- All vents, chimneys and flues are clear and well connected.

Additional Safety Tips

- Never use an oven or range as a space heater.
- Never let the car run in an attached garage.
- Never sleep in a room with an unvented gas or kerosene space heater.
- Never operate gasoline-powered engines (generators, chain saws, etc.) in enclosed spaces.
- Never use a barbecue or charcoal grill indoors.
