PGW OFFICES WILL BE CLOSED ON VETERANS DAY, TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 11, 2014

(Philadelphia, Pa. – November 10, 2014) – Philadelphia Gas Works' (PGW) Customer Service Centers will be closed on Tuesday, November 11, 2014, in observance of Veterans Day. Its Commercial Resource Center will also be closed.

At any time, all gas leaks or gas-related emergencies should be immediately reported by calling 215-235-1212.

PGW's Customer Service Centers will resume normal business hours on Wednesday, November 12. Normal hours are from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays (schedule below).

- Center City, 1137 Chestnut Street – Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday
- Frankford, 4410 Frankford Avenue – Tuesday, Thursday and Friday
- Germantown, 212 W. Cheltenham Avenue – Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday
- North Philadelphia, 1337 W. Erie Avenue – Monday, Wednesday and Thursday
- West Philadelphia, 5230 Chestnut Street – Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday

Both the Commercial Resource Center and the Residential Customer Call Center will resume normal business hours on Wednesday, November 12, 2014. The Customer Call Center is available from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. and the Commercial Resource Center operates between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

The number for billing-related calls or to turn gas service on or off is 215-235-1000. The number for PGW's Parts & Labor Plan is 215-235-2050. **All gas leaks or gas-related emergencies should be immediately reported by calling at 215-235-1212, anytime, 24 hours a day.**
